20 **AMENDED ORDER TO SHOW**
21 **CAUSE WHY AN ORDER GRANTING**
22 **RECOGNITION OF A FOREIGN**
23 **MAIN PROCEEDING SHOULD**
24 **NOT BE ENTERED**

25 On January 13, 2006, Ho Seok Lee as Court-Appointed Manager of Youngchang Co.,
Ltd (Petitioner) filed a Petition for Recognition of Foreign Main Proceeding seeking recognition
of the corporate reorganization proceeding commenced in the Incheon District Court,
Department of Bankruptcy, of the Republic of Korea by Youngchang Co., Ltd, pursuant to
Korea's Company Reorganization Act (Case No. 2004 Hoe 5,7). Petitioner seeks entry of an
order granting recognition as a foreign main proceeding pursuant to Chapter 15, Title 11 of
the United States Bankruptcy Code, and further seeks provisional relief against Samsung
Mfg., Ltd, a Korean corporation, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 1519. On January 25, 2006, the
Court entered an Order to Show Cause Why an Order Granting Recognition of a Foreign Main
Proceeding Should not be Entered requiring any party objecting to entry of the an order of

1 recognition to appear for a hearing on March 2, 2006. The Petitioner appeared at the March
2 2, 2006 hearing and requested that the show cause hearing be continued. Accordingly, it is
3 hereby

4 **ORDERED** that any party objecting to the entry of an order of recognition is required
5 (1) to appear on **May 25, 2006 at 10:30 a.m.** in **UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY COURT,**
6 **1717 Pacific Avenue, Courtroom H, Tacoma, Washington,** and (2) file and serve any
7 objection or response no later than **May 16, 2006,** as to why said Order of Recognition of a
8 Foreign Main Proceeding should not be entered; it is further

9 **ORDERED** that the Petitioner shall immediately serve a copy of its Petition for
10 Recognition of Foreign Main Proceeding and Application and this Amended Order to Show
11 Cause Why an Order Granting Recognition of a Foreign Main Proceeding Should not be
12 Entered upon the entity against whom it is seeking provisional relief, Samsung Mfg., Ltd, and
13 its Washington State counsel, Stuart R. Dunwoody.

14 Failure to file a written objection or response by **May 16, 2006,** and appear at said
15 hearing shall result in the Application being granted and an Order of Recognition of a Foreign
16 Main Proceeding being entered.
